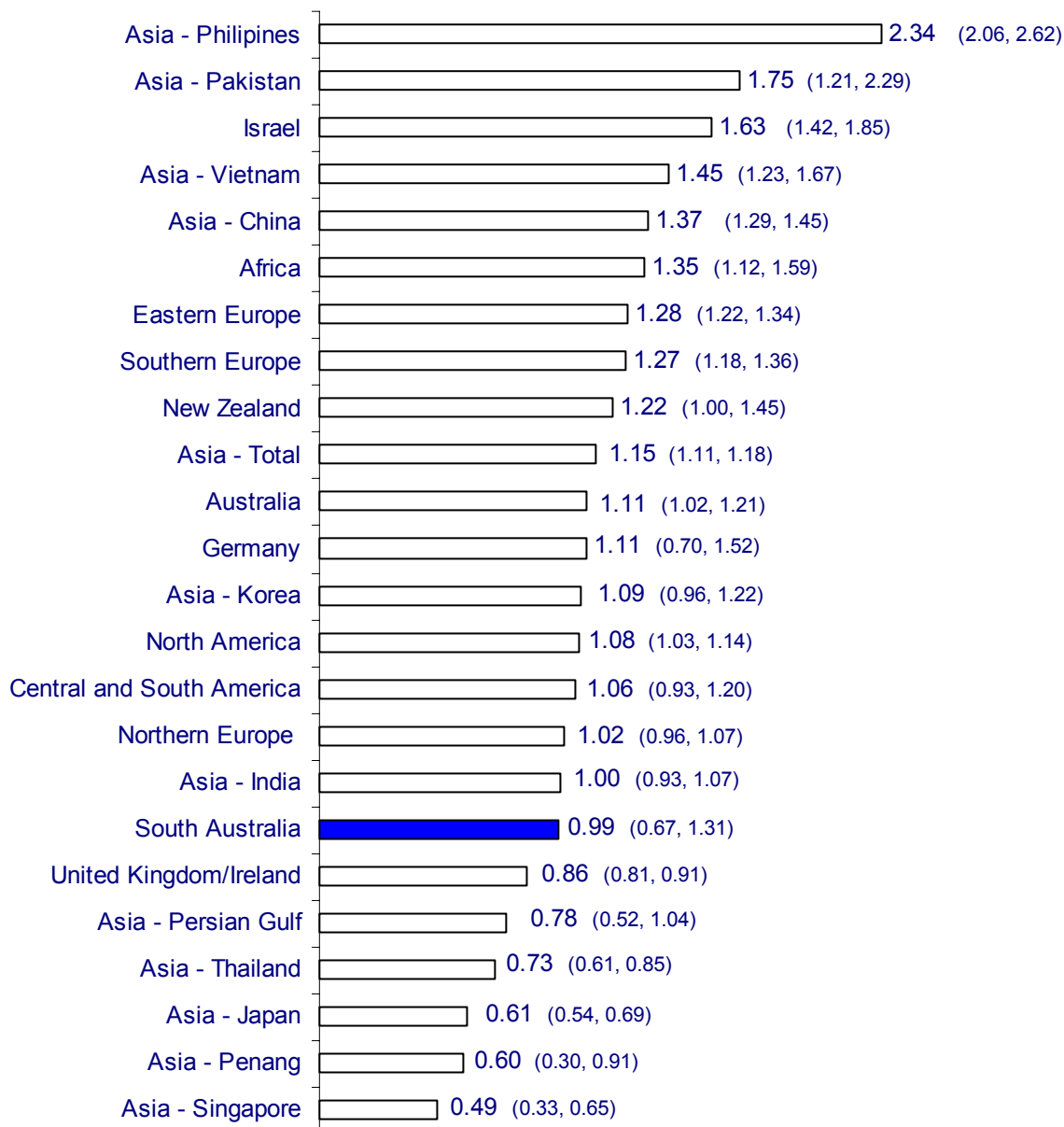


Annual incidence of cancer per 100,000 circa 1993-97 by region of the world (age-standardized to World Population)

Incidence (95% confidence limits)

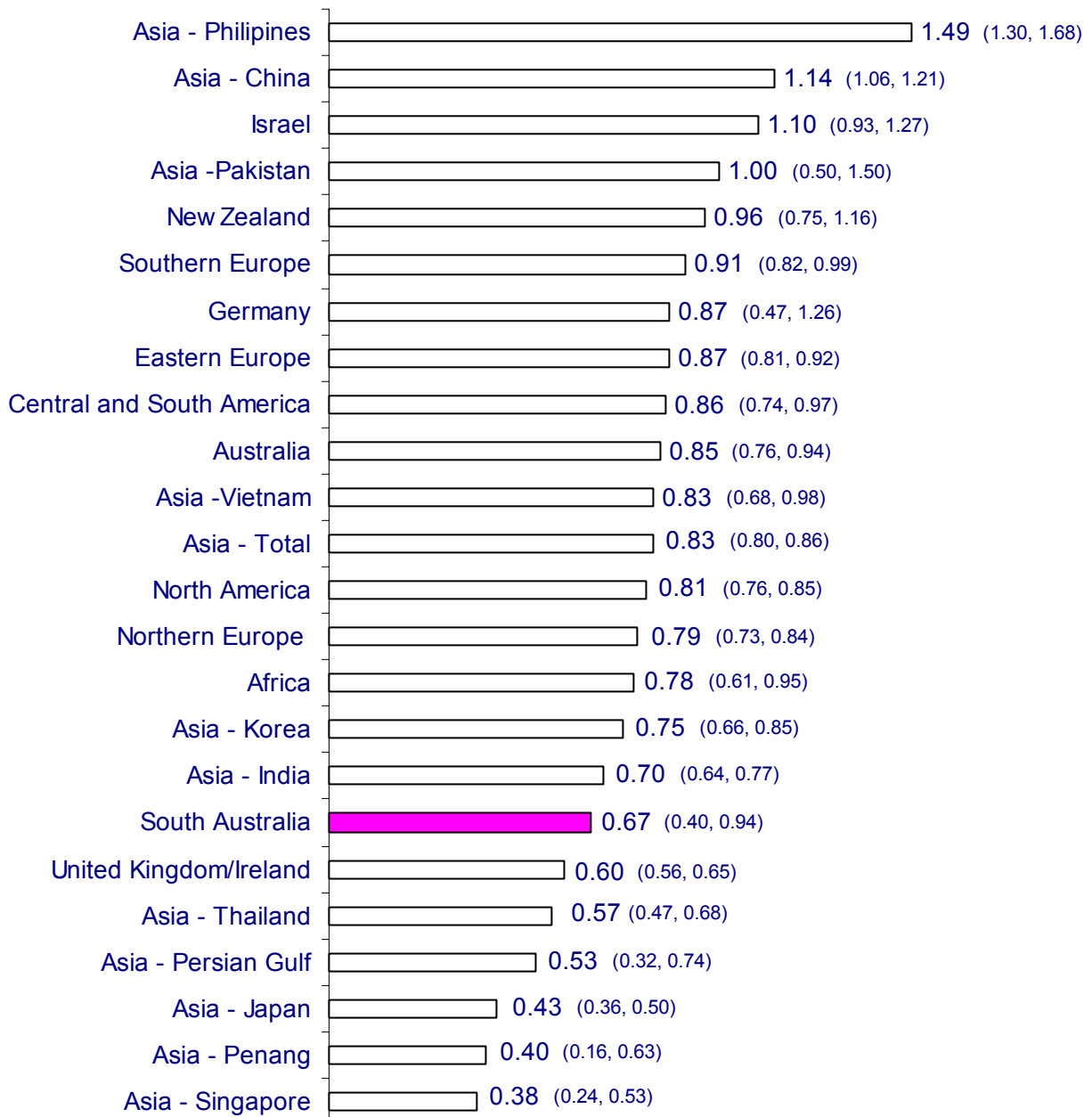


Annual incidence of cancer per 100,000 circa 1993-97 by region of the world (age-standardized to World Population)

Incidence (95% confidence limits)

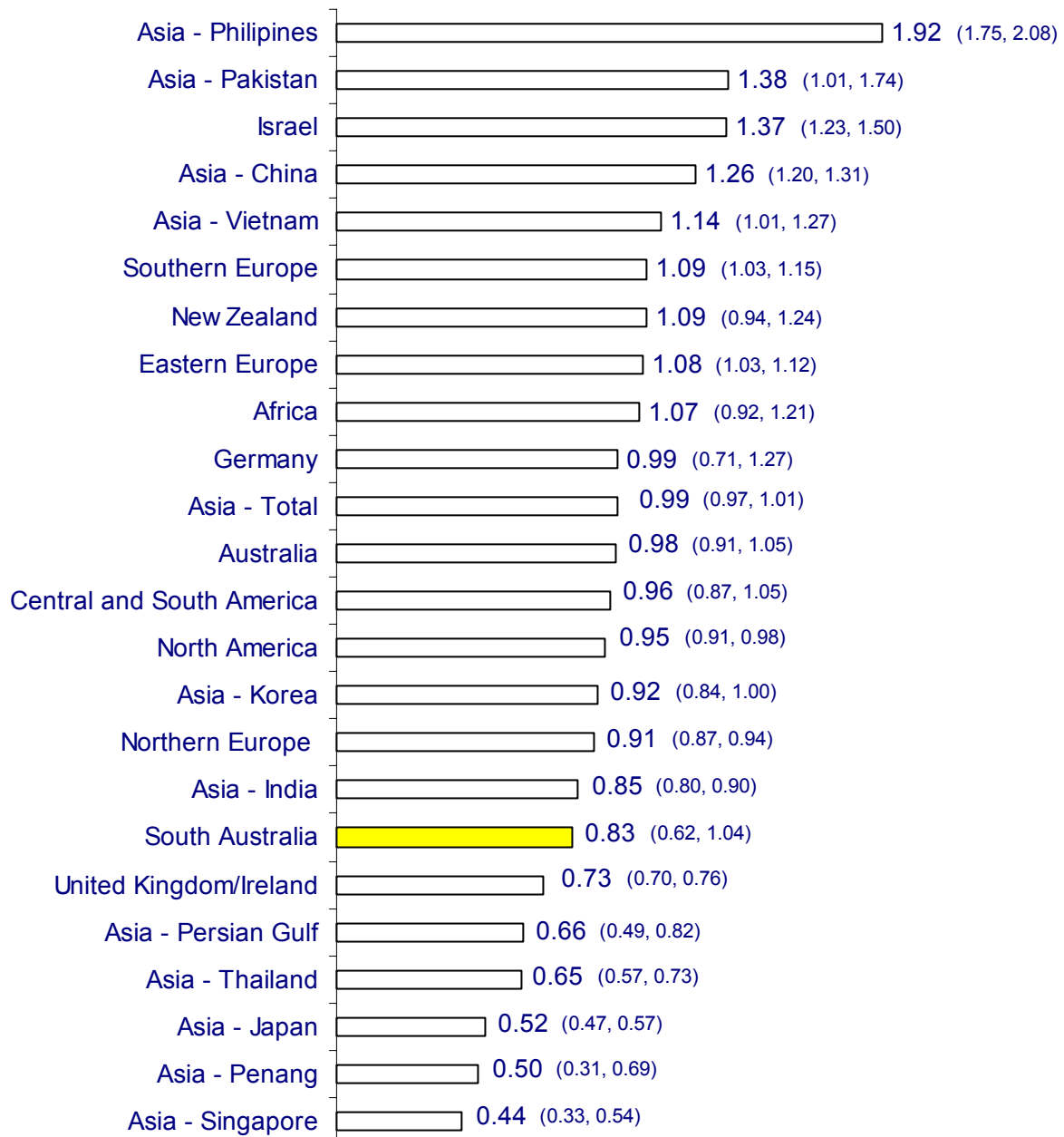


Annual incidence of cancer per 100,000 circa 1993-97 by region of the world (age-standardized to World Population)

BONE

- **The worldwide incidence of these cancers is low, with most inter-regional variations being small in magnitude and attributable to chance.**
- Similarly there was not compelling evidence of a variation by country of birth among South Australian residents during 1977-2000.
- Differences in incidence by socio-economic status, region of residence, and calendar year were not suggested for 1977-2001.
