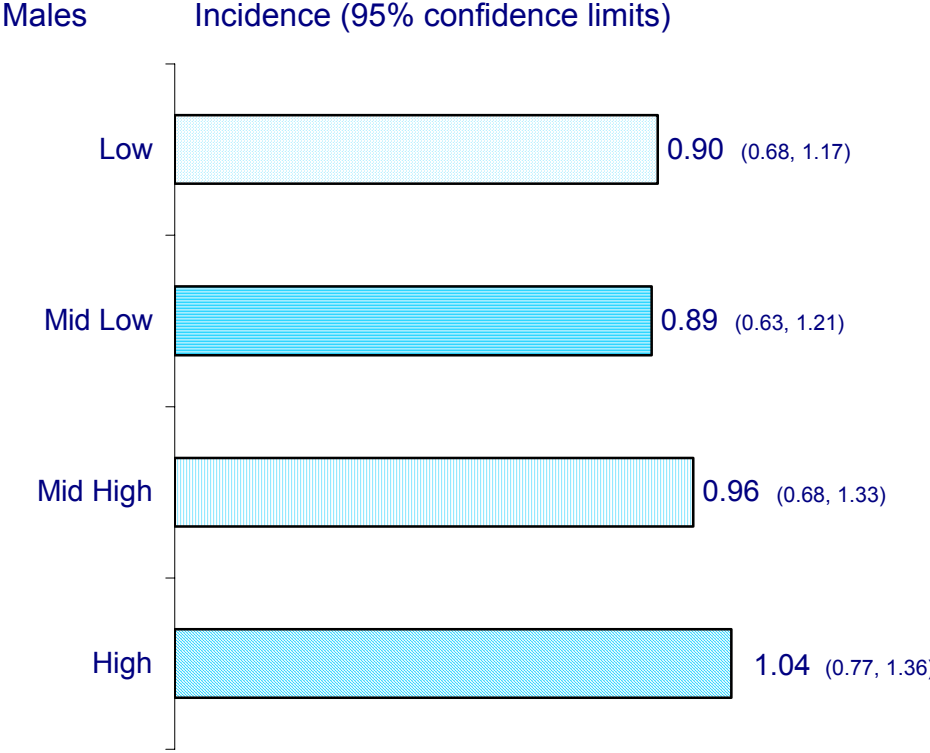


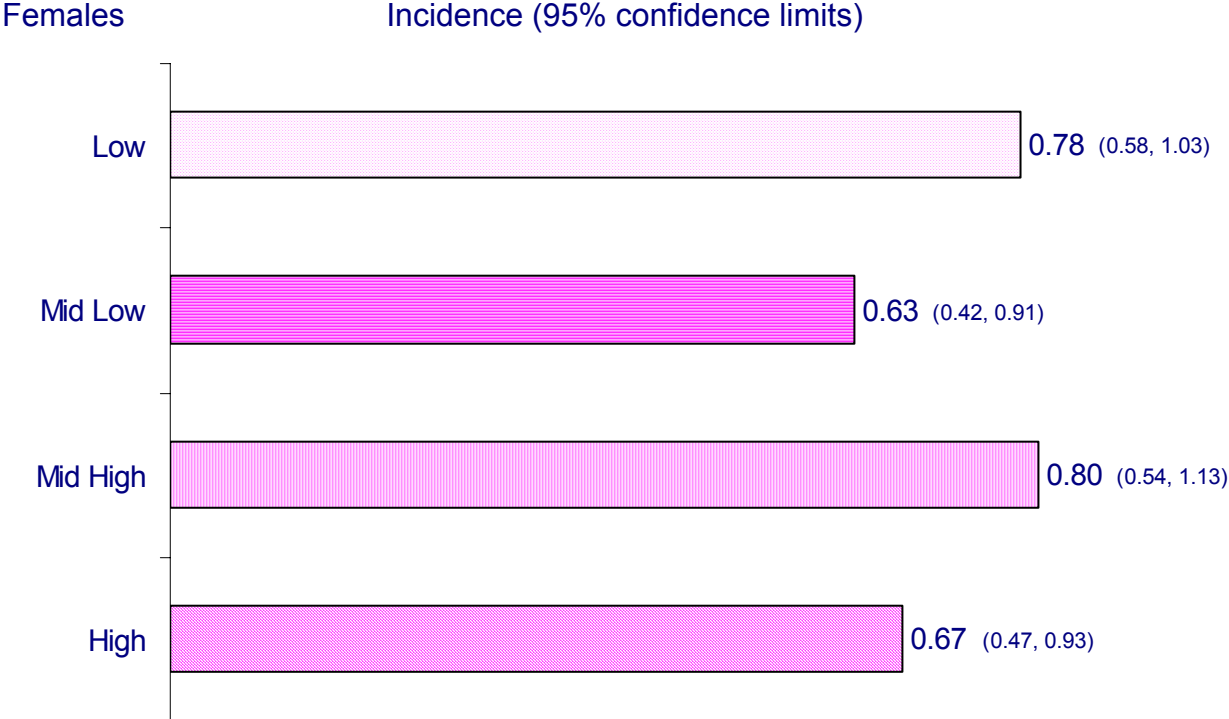
**Annual incidence of cancer in South Australia in 1977-2001 by socio-economic status of place of residence per 100,000 (age-standardized to World Population)**

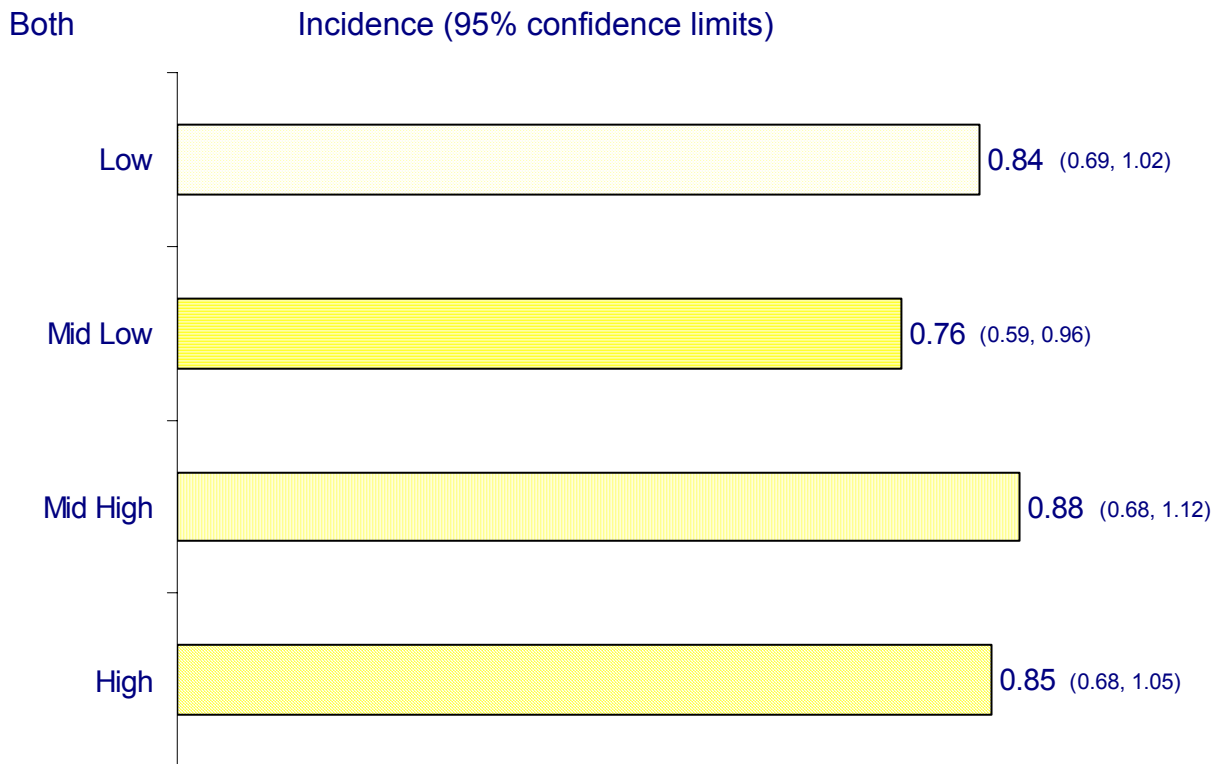
**Annual incidence of cancer in South Australia in 1977-2001 by socio-economic status of place of residence per 100,000 (age-standardized to World Population)**

## **BONE**

- The worldwide incidence of these cancers is low, with most inter-regional variations being small in magnitude and attributable to chance.
- Similarly there was not compelling evidence of a variation by country of birth among South Australian residents during 1977-2000.
- **Differences in incidence by socio-economic status, region of residence, and calendar year were not suggested for 1977-2001.**
