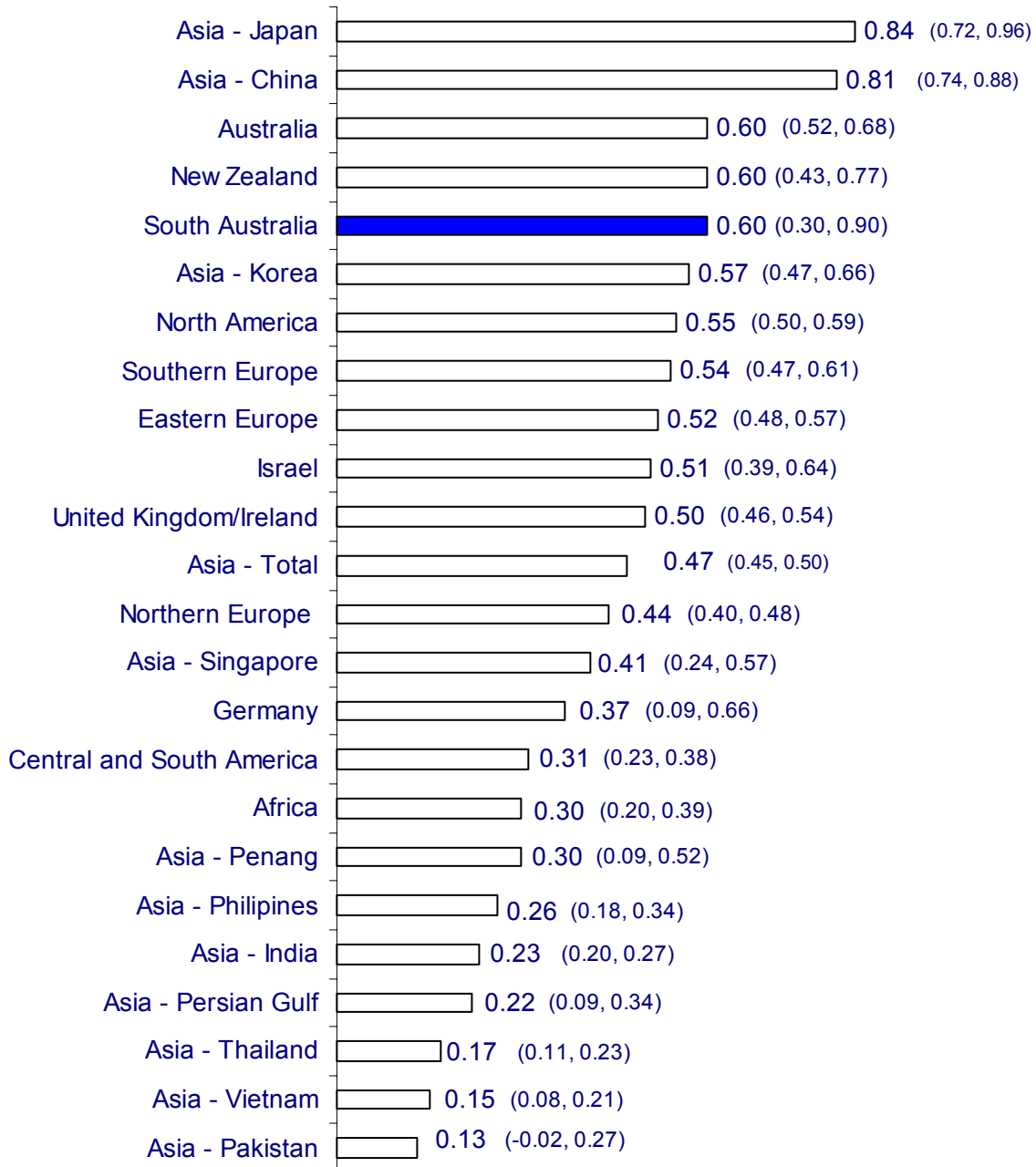


**Annual incidence of cancer per 100,000 circa 1993-97 by region of the world (age-standardized to World Population)**

Incidence (95% confidence limits)

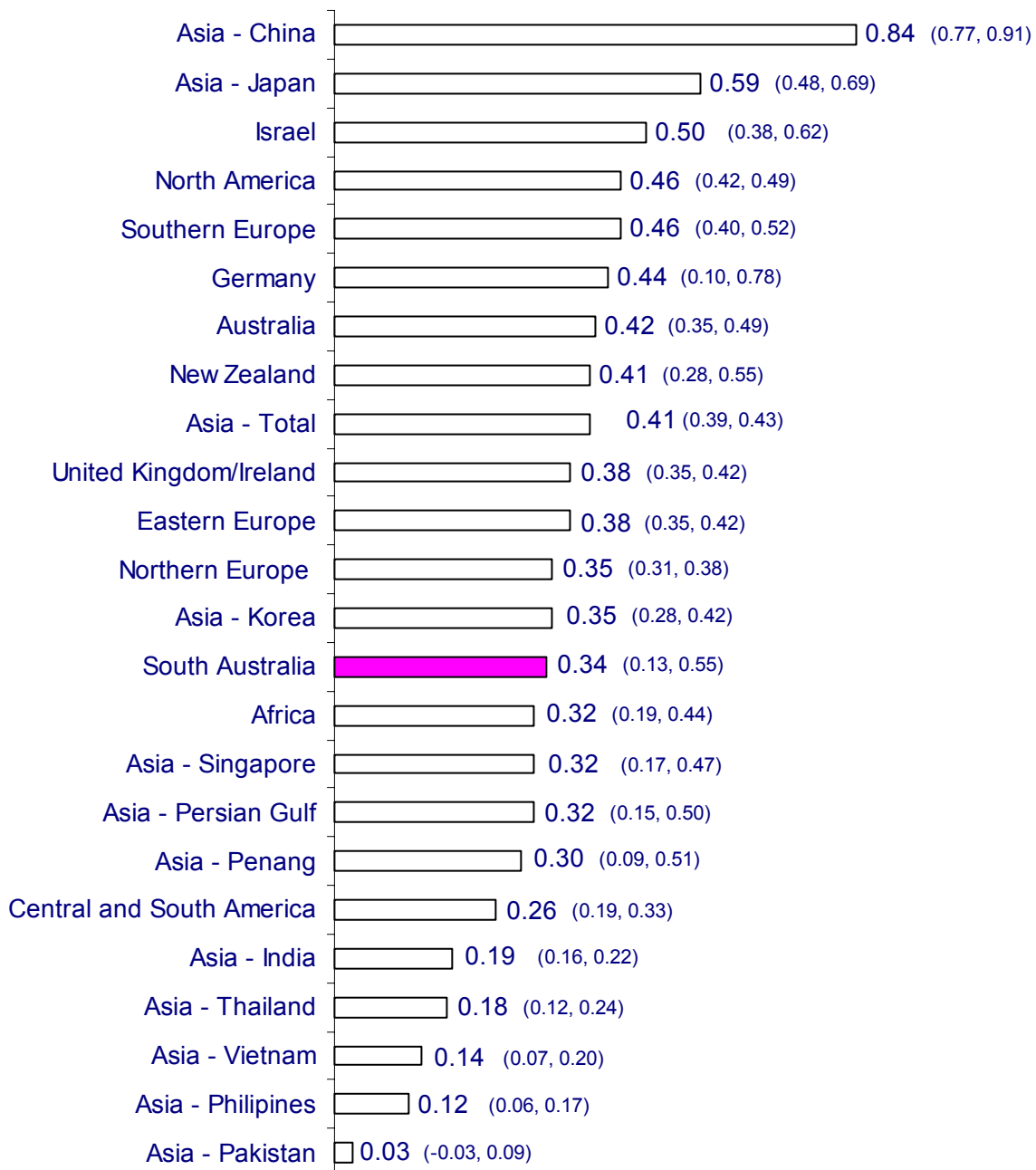


**Annual incidence of cancer per 100,000 circa 1993-97 by region of the world (age-standardized to World Population)**

Incidence (95% confidence limits)

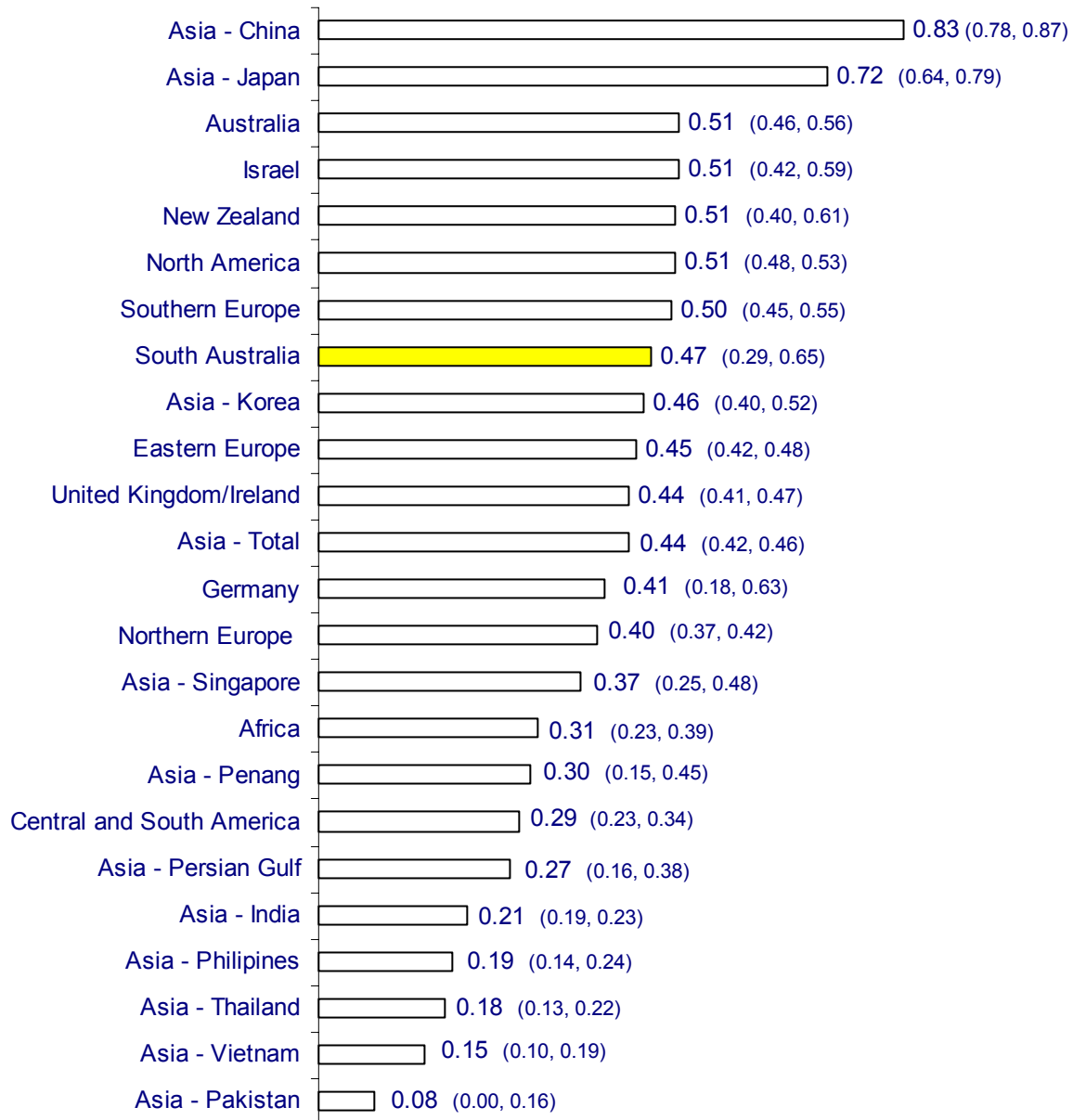


**Annual incidence of cancer per 100,000 circa 1993-97 by region of the world (age-standardized to World Population)**

## **OTHER ENDOCRINE**

- **Cancers of other endocrine glands are extremely rare, which complicates international comparisons of risk. South Australia presented an incidence in 1993-97 that was similar to other economically developed countries predominantly of European extraction.**
- Due to small numbers of cases in South Australia, effective comparisons of risk by country of birth, socio-economic status, region of residence or calendar year were not feasible.
