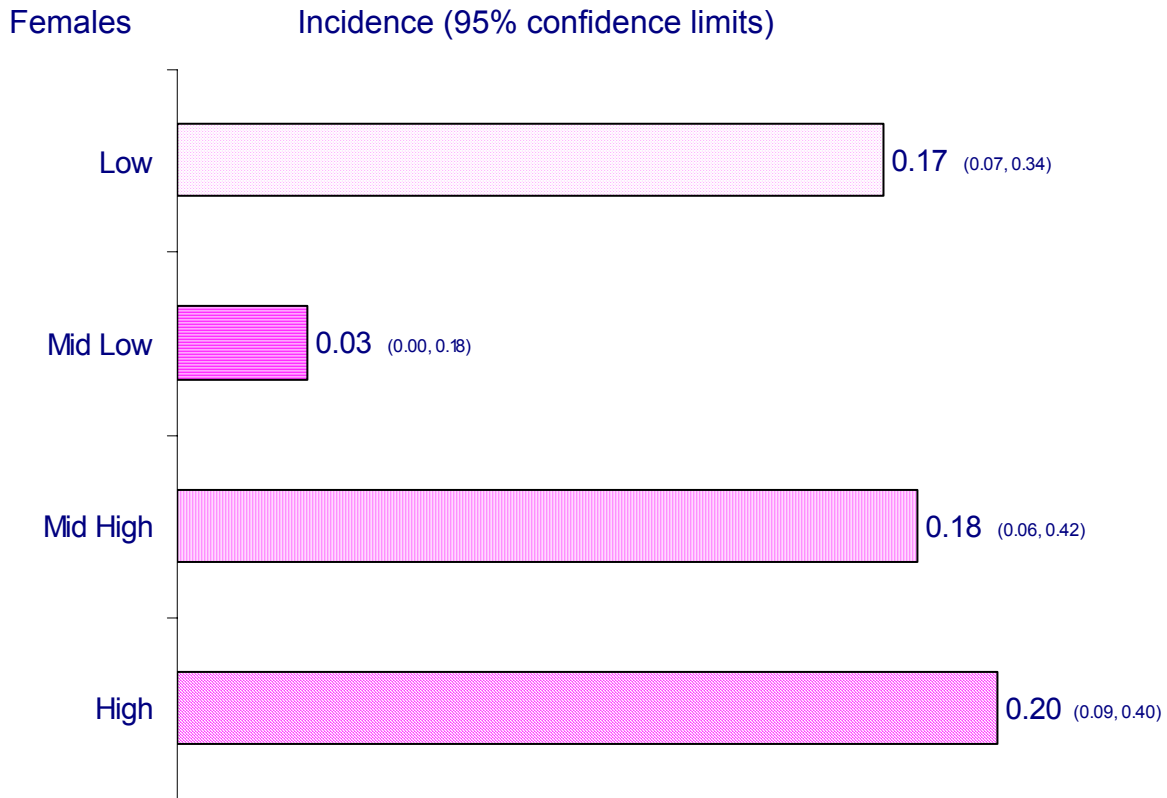


Annual incidence of cancer in South Australia in 1977-2001 by socio-economic status of place of residence per 100,000 (age-standardized to World Population)

PLACENTA

- Cancers of the placenta are generally too rare for comparative analysis by region of the world, although there is the indication of higher rates in Africa and Asia than in most parts of Europe, the United Kingdom/Ireland, North America and Australia.
- **Too few cases have presented in South Australia to assess differences by country of birth, socio-economic status, region of residence, or calendar year.**
