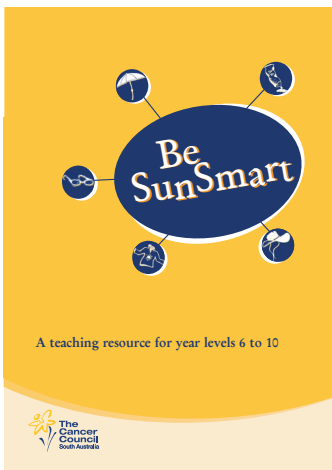

Many of the activities have associated fact sheets and worksheets for easy referencing and lesson planning.

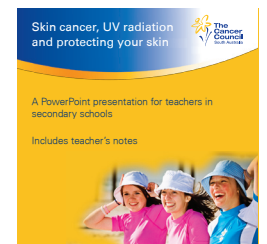


Real stories about skin cancer and skin damage – DVD and teacher resource book
