




What is UV?

Ultraviolet (UV) radiation:

- A form of energy emitted from the sun
- Cannot be seen or felt
- Affected by many factors such as:
 - time of day
 - time of year
 - cloud cover
 - altitude and reflection
 - amount of shade
 - but *NOT* temperature


Scattered and reflected UV
